



Athletic Forms

Each athlete is required to complete several forms prior to the first day of tryouts.

- The [ATHLETIC PHYSICAL EXAM FORM](#) is required of all athletics. It is valid for a period of two years.
- Each parent and athlete must sign a [HEAD CONCUSSION LETTER](#) acknowledging that they are aware of the dangers of injuries to the head.
- [ATHLETIC CLEARANCE FORM](#) is to be completed each school year. Each sport that the athletic intends to play should be noted on this form. Parent and athlete must initial this form that they have read
- Both the student and parent must read carefully and acknowledge by signing the Athletic Clearance form, and initialing that they have read the [ATHLETIC CODE](#) and an Insurance Information form (below) for each sport prior to participating

Transportation Forms

Coaches require a [TRANSPORT OWN CHILD](#) form to be completed if the parent chooses to transport (only) their own child after an athletic competition. Form is to be given to the coach prior to the event.

If an athlete is to ride home with another parent please complete an [AUTHORIZATION FOR STUDENT TO TRAVEL WITH ANOTHER PARENT](#) form. Form is to be given to the coach prior to the athletic event.

Medication Forms

Athletes may carry and self administer certain medications. In addition to the [MEDICATION AT SCHOOL](#) form the [AUTHORIZATION FOR SELF-ADMINISTRATION OF ASTHMA/ANAPHYLAXIS MEDICATION](#) form is to be completed.
