Klahowya students do not have lockers so it is recommended that ALL students carry their supplies and personal items in a backpack. A 3-ring binder with dividers, paper, pens, and pencils are necessary supplies. Individual teachers may require special classroom supplies in addition to the following required fees.

REQUIRED STUDENT AGENDA PLANNER PURCHASE

To assist all students in meeting the goal of academic success, we are requiring the use of a time management tool. The planner includes a calendar, daily assignment log, specific Klahowya student information, and other valuable resources. The important planner will be available to purchase at the bookkeepers office for only \$3.00. Planners purchased in August will be distributed in the gym on the first day of school. Students who stay on top of their daily assignments from the beginning are better assured of academic success.

REQUIRED ATHLETIC FEE AND ASB PRIVILEGE

All students who participate in any school sport will be required to purchase a \$30.00 ASB card. Additionally, all athletes will be charged an athletic fee. \$75.00 for HS and \$50.00 for MS. This fee is to help defray the cost of transportation and officials.

REQUIRED FOREIGN LANGUAGE MATERIALS

REQUIRED HS CHOIR FEE

Each student enrolled in a high school choir class will be required to pay a \$10.00 fee. This fee will pay for dry cleaning charges for robes and other performance garments.

REQUIRED MATH SUPPLIES AND FEES

Students enrolled in AT1 and AT2 classes will need a scientific calculator, plenty of notebook paper, a binder and pencils. Students in AG1 and above will need a graphing calculator (preferably Texas Instrument 83 or 84), graph paper, notebook paper, pencils, a binder or folder to organize work and notes.

Each student enrolled in a math class will be charged a \$2.00 Math Supply fee. This fee covers calculator batteries, graphing paper, pencils, etc.

REQUIRED PARKING PERMIT

Each student that drives a car to school will be required to park in either the underclass or senior parking lot. A guardian/parent and student driver is required to complete and sign a parking permit form and \$10.00 fee.

REQUIRED SCIENCE LAB FEE AND SUPPLIES

Students enrolled in a science class (1 fee if multi-science classes) will be required to pay a \$5.00 lab fee. This fee is for consumables and lab supplies. Students enrolled in Mrs. Flint or McNulty's class will be required to purchase a 100 page, single subject, college ruled, spiral notebook preferably with a hard cover.

KLAHOWYA P.E. UNIFORMS

The physical education department strongly recommends students to purchase a Klahowya P.E. uniform. Uniforms may be purchased from the bookkeepers office. Students must present the bookkeeper receipt to the physical education teacher to receive his/her uniform. The uniform consists of forest green shorts and a white T-shirt with a Klahowya insignia. The price of the uniform is \$12.50 or shorts can be purchased for \$8.00 and the T-shirt is \$4.50. Students that wish to wear a sweatshirt or sweatpants are encouraged to wear school colors (either green, black or gray).

It has been determined that wearing school P.E. uniforms helps to prevent locker thefts, enhances classroom management, and promotes better hygiene. All P.E. Clothing should be clearly marked with the student name in the left from shoulder.

White cotton sweat socks and a pair of lace-up athletic shoes (with good arch support) is also recommended.

Locks and baskets will be issued the first day of the semester. Students will be fined \$5.00 for any lock not returned at the end of the semester.

YEARBOOK

The cost of a yearbook is \$50.00 (\$45.00 with ASB card). This price is available until 10/30. The cost will increase by \$10.00 at that time.
